

Notifications and Accretions

Notifications and Accretions are differences with a patient's record between CROWNWeb and another CMS external source.* *External sources* can be EDB (Electronic Database) or Others.

	Identity Notification	Event Notification	Accretion
Definition	A difference that involves a patient's Last Name, First Name, Date of Birth, Gender, Social Security Number or Medicare Claim Number.	A difference that involves Date of Death, Transplants, Transplant Failures, or Treatments of a patient.	A patient record from a CMS external source that has not yet been admitted into your facility in CROWNWeb.
Accept <i>If you <u>agree</u> with the External Source suggestion.</i>	This will automatically update the new information on the Patient Attributes page.	Accepting still requires you to make the identified update in the patient record. (DoD, tx status, treatment, modality)	This will take you to the Admit Patient page to admit the patient.
	Check the Checkbox and select Submit again.	Check the Checkbox and select Submit again.	
Reject <i>If you <u>disagree</u> with the External Source suggestion.</i>	This will keep the current CROWNWeb information the same. The notification will be considered resolved.	This will keep the current CROWNWeb information the same. The notification will be considered resolved.	The patient is either not ESRD or is already in CROWNWeb.
Investigate <i>If you are unsure and need to do further research.</i>	The record remains on your list until you Accept/Reject .	The record remains on your list until you Accept/Reject .	The record remains on your list until you Accept/Reject .
Escalate <i>If the patient is <u>not your patient</u>.</i>	The notification will be reassigned to the Network.	The notification will be reassigned to the Network.	The accretion will be reassigned to the Network.
