



Crown Web Evaluation Checklist

In preparation for the launch of Crown Web in February, all dialysis facilities must have in place the following:

Windows XP/Vista Computer (no 95/98/NT/W2K; no MAC or Unix)
High Speed Internet Connection (DSL, Cable, T1 :: *No Dial-Up*
Security Administrator* (creates QIPS accounts)
CMS/Network Trained Facility Administrator** (assigns Crown Web Roles & Scope)
CMS/Network Trained Facility Editor** (enters / modifies data in the Crown Web system)

* WebEx Training Sessions, October 21st – October 31st

** In-Class Training Sessions, January 6th – January 31st

It is also recommended that each facility have the following:

CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Security Administrator
CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Facility Administrator
CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Facility Editor

Additionally, all users of the Crown Web System must:

Have a unique email address (corporate email is preferred)
Complete, sign, and have notarized the Crown Web CAS Access Form
