



### ***CrownWeb Evaluation Checklist***

All dialysis facilities must have in place the following in order to access CROWNWeb:

	Windows <b>XP/Vista</b> Computer (no 95/98/NT/W2K; no MAC or Unix)
	<b>High Speed</b> Internet Connection (DSL, Cable, T1 :: <b>*No Dial-Up*</b> )
	Internet Explorer 8 is the only usable web browser ( <i>Safari and FireFox are not supported</i> )
	<b>Security Administrator*</b> (creates QIPS accounts)
	CMS/Network Trained <b>Facility Administrator*</b> (assigns Crown Web Roles & Scope)
	CMS/Network Trained <b>Facility Editor</b> (enters/modifies data in the Crown Web system)

\* Note: Security Administrator and Facility Administrator can be the same person.

It is also recommended that each facility have the following:

	CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Security Administrator
	CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Facility Administrator
	CMS/Network/Facility Trained Backup Facility Editor

Additionally, all users of the CrownWeb System must:

	Have a <b>unique</b> email address (corporate email is preferred)
	Complete, sign, and have notarized the CrownWeb QIPs Access Form
