



Immunization/Vaccination Survey Instructions

Attached with this mailing is your facility's "**Patient Roster**" as January 31, 2010. **You may use this roster in collecting the information needed for this scan.** Please do not remove or add any patient on this list. Your facility's vaccination rate will be based according to the total number of patients listed on this roster. Please note that the "**Patient Roster**" is for your reference only and does not need to be returned to Network 18.

1. Number of patients who received **Influenza Vaccine** from August 2009 – January 2010
 - Patients to be included are those who are listed in your "**Patient Roster**" who received the Influenza Vaccine during the period beginning **August 1, 2009** and ending in **January 31, 2010**.

Example: "*Did you get your flu shot this flu season (Aug 09-Jan 10)?*" "*From where?*"

2. Number of patients who have received **Pneumonia Vaccine** as of January 31, 2010.
 - Patients to be included are those who are listed in your "**Patient Roster**" who received at least **one (1) or more Pneumonia Vaccine** from **any** health care provider before and/or after becoming an ESRD patient.

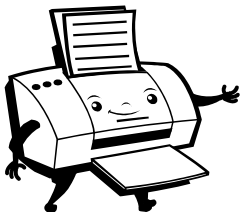
Example: "*Have you ever had the Pneumonia Vaccine?*"

3. Number of patients who received a **complete Hepatitis B Vaccine** series as of January 31, 2010.
 - Patients to be included are those who are listed in your "**Patient Roster**" who received at least **one (1) or more "completed" Hepatitis B Vaccine series** from any health care provider **before and/or after** becoming an ESRD patient.

Example: "*Have you ever had a "completed" series of shots for Hepatitis B?*"
